

COVID Safety at Tree Pittsburgh

Keeping Your Camper Safe

Tree Pittsburgh is dedicated to providing your camper with a fun, interactive camp experience while prioritizing safety during COVID-19. Using guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and the Pennsylvania State Department of Health, we have developed protocols for maintaining safety while enjoying the outdoors!



- STEAM Outside Camp will take place outdoors to the maximum extent possible. As such, campers should be prepared to spend the entire camp day outdoors and bring what they need to be safe and comfortable including sunscreen, towel, and raincoat. Please also bring a change of clothes if rain is in the forecast. Tree Pittsburgh has a large covered pavilion to shield us from the elements.
- We will take refuge indoors only if it is unsafe to be outside (thunderstorms, high winds, or other weather hazards). We have assessed our indoor spaces and identified areas where each camp group can shelter while maintaining 6-foot social distancing.
- Masks are required at all times. Due to the likelihood of masks becoming wet or soiled during the course of the day, campers should bring at least one spare mask each day, kept in a plastic bag in their lunchbox or backpack.
- Campers must bring their own lunch and may not share food with other campers.
- Camp activities (including lunch) will be conducted in groups of 10 campers who will not mix with others during the camp day.
- A complete safety measure will be mailed to parents before camp begins.
